It was proposed and passed to add salad to the holiday party meal. It was also passed to provide water, soda, and coffee. Up to \$500 will be spent for gift cards.

At the holiday party there will be no speaker. The new board will be installed and gift cards will be awarded.

COMMITTEE REPORTS: DC reported that he has been working with several organizations to recruit candidates. So far there have been no applicants.
